

## Health Insurance in Sonoma County: A Quick Guide to Your Options

Starting **January 1, 2014** most residents will be required to have health insurance. If you don't have insurance, you can enroll in the options below beginning **November 1, 2015** for coverage that starts **January 1, 2016**.
